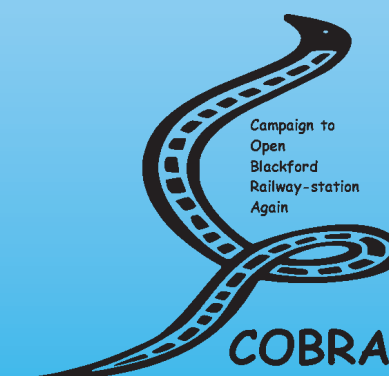

- Reduce pollution

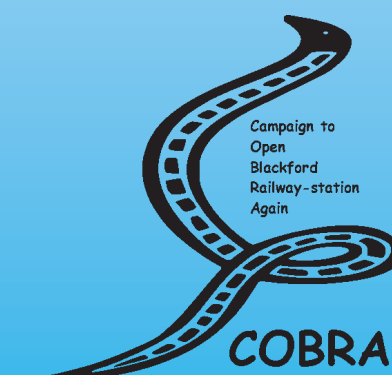
